We worked with riders of different age and range of ability...youngest rider is 2 yo, the oldest 35.

Leukodystrophy, Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Frederic's Ataxia, Prader Willi Syndrome, Developmental Delay, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder...are some of condition of our riders...

Lessons has been conducted by Kate White Davorka Suvak, NARHA Certified Therapeutic Riding Instructors at Great Falls facility and in Middleburg , Golden Dreams program.

Whole program was managed and has been run by thousands of voluntary hours in all areas – from barn management, paperwork, fundraising, marketing, to lesson assistance and maintenance work at facility...

No one rider has been denied because of lack of finances. In this moment, two riders ride without any of charge, as part of our program activity.

In past months we worked with great horses:

- Spirit, since end of December 2006 (40 yo pony mare, purchased by Davorka Suvak for start of Spirit Program)
- Louie, since January until July 2007 (19 yo Morgan gelding, donated by Purrsefield Farm, Hannah Salazar, agent, kept at GD farm , given back to owner)
- Angel, since May until July 2007 (9 yo TB mare, donated by Ms Becky Trisdale, given back as pregnant)
- Pine Oaks Infinity, since August 2007 (15 yo Morgan mare, donated by Ms Courtney King)
