In 2021 SPIRIT was able to resume full programming offering a total of 41 weeks of classes for Therapeutic Riding and Equine Assisted Learning through FCPA, 5 weeks of Equine Assisted Learning Summer Camps through FCPA, community workshops through our SPIRIT Academy, and continue unmounted programs of Therapeutic Horsemanship and Equine Assisted Psychotherapy.
